Task Descriptions

- **Compassion Host:** Now that you are eager to share your passion of LSS/NCA with others, you can host Compassion in Action. To be a host, you need to bring ten friends to a tour in a year. You can invite them to a tour pre-scheduled in our offices or we will go to your home, church, book club—wherever is convenient for you!
- **Foster Care Respite:** Become certified in foster care guardianship so you can give foster parents the night off. This is the perfect opportunity to have influence on a child in need when you don't have the time or room to be a full time foster parent.
- **Activity Host;** Foster parents are required to take classes and trainings to ensure certification. Serve as an activity host during these trainings so the children can play, learn, and socialize while their foster parents are in class!
- **Driver:** Transportation volunteers are critical to refugees' success. Drivers help get people to job interviews, medical appointments, etc. They also may be asked to pick up families at the airport or donations from LSS/NCA in-kind donors. Most needs arise during the week.
- **Family Mentor:** Help a family adjust to their new life. Many are eager to improve their English and often need help job searching but families are also looking for companionship & guidance as they settle into their new hometown. Mentors are asked to visit with the family for a minimum of one hour weekly.
- **Front Desk/Donations:** We work with very little staff in a very busy office. During office hours, you could be a huge help by answering the door, taking phone calls, and organizing in-kind donations.
- **Professional Mentor:** If you are in engineering, teaching, accounting, or nursing, we need your help to get refugees re-certified or find jobs in your field. Refugees also need help writing resumes and practicing interviews.
- **Culinary Adventurer:** Refugees come without a community, and often without their families. Having a neighbor include them in family time or holidays can mean a lot. Dinners are informal and can be with a group of people from the neighborhood, church, or other friends.
- **Big Hearts, Big Muscles:** Help make a house a home by getting things ready for a new family to arrive. We are looking for muscles to move big furniture into new apartments, as well as big hearts to make beds, put dishes away and make a home cozy! We would need a few hours during the week.
- **Camp Counselor:** Join families and children who live with or have been affected by HIV for Youth Haven Camps and Retreats. A camp counselor may oversee child/teen activities, lead group discussions, or supervise cabins. Must be available overnight and weekends.
